Additional Comments

I valued the humour - many training events are too formal. I will share the information with staff for use with all children. I would have liked more time.

I valued the inclusive strategies for working with children and breaking down understanding. I will use for all staff training.

I valued all of it! I will feedback to staff and will use in own practice with one child in particular. I would have liked a whole day.

I valued the style of teaching. Fintan was very engaging and humorous. I intend to run a training session with school staff.

I valued the humour and the strategies. I will feedback to staff. The room was a bit small.

I valued the entire presentation/course/handouts - all excellent. As SENDCo I will use this during Inset to inform staff and help build better/good rapport with certain children.

Important messages to hear. I will reflect and refine practice.

Interesting and informative ideas for dealing with situations. I liked the humour! It felt a bit rushed towards the end - time for questions would have been good.

I valued having the chance to step back from issues and reflect on what we are already doing right, and to consider new approaches. I will share with staff, particularly 1 to 1 staff for specific children.

Very thought provoking and lots of strategies to support in the classroom. I would hope for you to come and deliver the training to all staff at my school. I would have liked more time.

I valued the examples given. I will feed back to staff and use information when working with and supporting ODD/ASD/ADHD children and their parents, making ours an inclusive school. I would have liked more opportunities to share our experiences.

I valued the key points, particularly with reference to mood. Three of us attended from the same school so it will be more effective to implement into the school. I would have liked a little bit longer so that the end wasn't rushed.

I valued the humour and the personal stories. I will reflect on the strategies I am using.

I valued the insight into behaviours and the anecdotes. I will cascade the need to know a child to all our staff along with the idea that fairness means giving them what they need. The venue was cramped and a bit noisy.

The presenter made it fun and informative. This had a massive impact on me - how to distract children, to understand them and their needs.

Hearing what I thought was how to deal with children with ODD backs and boosts my confidence. I will discuss with the rest of my staff and use practical strategies suggested. I would have liked slightly longer.

I valued the tips and strategies. Fintan was very easy to listen to! I will look at how/what things are said and explore distraction. I would have liked longer.

I valued the practical approaches in working with people. I will apply when circumstances arrive. All good - thank you.

I valued the teaching ideas e.g. 'draw' game - finger counting. A wealth of information. I plan to feed forward in a staff meeting. I would have liked the acronyms to be clearer.

The course was relevant to what was needed. I can use the skills learned and pass on to colleagues.

I valued the thoughts about mood and details about particular difficulties, e.g. ODD/ADHD etc. I will consider how we approach each child with difficulties. I would have liked the group to sit around tables, it would have been easier with a bit more space.

Interesting and amusing presentation. Practical strategies for managing situations - in presentation and anecdotal. I will disseminate practical strategies to staff and promote a deeper understanding of ODD. I would cut out the ADHD/ASD/SPLD slides and spend more time on strategies and practical solutions.

I valued the quality of information provided - the training was delivered well. I will aim to develop better rapport with children.

I valued the knowledge of the trainer and his ability to relate it to different settings. I will be working directly with pupils and developing their strategies in relation to ODD. I will be feeding back to colleagues to increase team understanding and approach. I would have liked longer.
